Gun-Free Schools Policy

The Gun-Free Schools Policy prohibits anyone from bringing a firearm onto school property. The term firearm means: any weapon (including a starter gun) which will or is designed to or may readily be converted to expel a projectile by the action of an explosive; the frame or receiver of such weapon; any fire arm muffler or silencer; or any destructive device. Antique firearms are excluded.

Any student found guilty of bringing a firearm onto school premises or having a firearm in his or her possession at school, after a hearing, will be suspended from school for no less than a year. However, the Superintendent may review and modify the penalty on a case-by-case basis.
